This wonderful show has been a very popular one for the past several years. All entries in this show must be black, white and/or gray, including the matting and frame. Art of any medium, depicting the artist’s choice of subject, may be entered. *Children ages 4 – 14 are encouraged to enter this show as well.*

INTAKE is October 7th through October 29th. To enter send a photograph of your art and a **signed** entry form to Bob Curtis at [bcurtis97304@gmail.com](mailto:bcurtis97304@gmail.com).

**There will be no reception.** However, Saturday, October 31st, the announcement of all awards will be placed on the KAA website and each winner and KAA members will receive an email announcing the awards.

The “Black, White and Gray” show runs from October 29 through December 1st.

### THE FOLLOWING ARE GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ALL KAA SHOWS:

Keizer Art Association reserves the right to jury submitted art for suitability and as space limitations mandate. Please refer to guidelines below for further details.

#### Art Media

- 2D - Two dimensional pieces, such as: watercolor, oil, acrylic, mixed media, colored pencil or fabric art.
- Photography – Any image created within the confines of a camera and using camera related adjustments in post processing for lighting, contrast, color, sharpness, cropping, etc.
- Digital Art – Photos edited and changed using artistic filter adjustments in post processing, photo painting, digital collages, integrated art, digital painting or any other artistic rendition using a computer and software.
- 3D – Pieces show width, height and depth, such as: carving, modeling, or welding materials into a work of art (for example, a sculpture).
- Youth Art – Any of the above media entered by children 4 – 14 years of age.

### Entry Mandates

- All work must be original to the artist.
- All media are acceptable and the show is open to all artists.
- Edges of unframed wall art must be suitably finished (no visible staples/jagged edges).
- Jewelry and other small objects should be displayed in a secure, professional manner.
- Artwork exhibited in this gallery within the past two years is not acceptable.
- Up to four entries per artist are permitted.
- Entries must be listed on Entry Form. **THE ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED.** The entry form attached to this prospectus is the only entry form which may be used. Print it, fill it out, scan it into your computer and email it with pictures of your entries to Bob Curtis, [bcurtis97304@gmail.com](mailto:bcurtis97304@gmail.com) . If you cannot scan, take a picture of your completed and **signed** entry form and email it to Bob. If you are unable to scan or take a photo of your form, mail your entry form via U.S Postal Service, to Keizer Art Association, 980 Chemawa Rd. NE, Keizer, Or 97303 which must be received prior October 27th. If you mail to KAA in Keizer, you must email KAA to let someone know so it can be picked up and sent to Bob Curtis. Award winners of this show should to be ready, if they desire, to show, for the month of December, their art at the Keizer Civic Center complete with frames, mats and glass. Winners of awards will be contacted by Terry Dempsey regarding participation in the show at the Keizer Civic Center.

### Awards

This exhibit is juried and ribbons will be awarded for best of show and for juror's merit award; and for first, second and third place in each of these categories: 2-D art, photography, digital art, 3D and youth art. The decision of the judge(s) is final. A \$50 award will be given to the artist of the best of show.

### Entry Fees

- There is no fee to enter this show. Donations to KAA will be kindly accepted.

### Sale of Art

- Commission fee for sales is 60% to the artist and 40% to KAA.
